And if ultra-slow working speeds are required it's also possible to specify a creep speed reduction gearbox in addition to the main transmission.



JXT tractors come with world-renowned FPT engines, (55 hp -75 hp models) or Simpson engines (35 hp to 47 hp working range with a lower drop in rpm. In the optional Tier 3 models) known for ruggedness, reliability and excellent torque characteristics. With their high engine backup torque, JXT tractors can deal effortlessly with sudden loads at

constant engine rpm. They deliver more power in the version, the turbocharger increases the oxygen available to the engine, optimising fuel combustion.
